

# CHIP Co-payment—Doctor Visit When Your Child is Sick or Needs Counseling

- 1 Find your family size on the left side of this chart.
- 2 Follow that row to the right and find your monthly income range.\* The amount to the right will show what you will need to pay for a doctor visit for your children if they have CHIP.

**Note:** Vaccinations and checkups are always free with CHIP and there are no co-payments for any services if your children have Medicaid.
