

CHIP Co-payment — Emergency Room Visit

(for non-emergency visits only)

- 1 Find your family size on the left side of this chart.
- 2 Follow that row to the right and find your monthly income range.* The amount to the right will show what you will need to pay for an emergency room visit for your children if they have CHIP. There are no co-payments if your children have Children’s Medicaid.
